



Welcome to the Sewing Tuition 10-day Certificated Course. This programme has been designed for personal achievement or for those wishing to start their own small business. Your sessions here at Sewing Tuition, are nicely spaced out, to fit in with your lifestyle. You will make good sized sample soft furnishings, based on current popular items. Plus, lots of sewing tips. You receive 20 fabric packs in all !

Your days will be in a relaxed, clean and inspirational environment, working at your own pace in our professional sewing workroom. You will have access to our equipment during your time here & advice on their uses. You will receive first-hand small business advice if required, based on 40 years practical & 30 years teaching experience, on this specially designed course in Oxfordshire.

You will learn how to make an item in class under expert supervision, along with ongoing question & answers during your time in our Sewing Tuition workroom – do ask as many questions as you wish!

8	Headboards - continued		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Decide on headboard shape • Cut out the base board • Cut & apply the foam • Apply the main fabric • Make a rouched border & apply • Discuss different borders • Complete an impressive 'Quarter size' double Headboard
9	Dining Chair Covers – Day 1		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Measure each section • Calculate fabric quantities • Allow for seams • Make & apply piping • Cut out quantities economically • Fit your chair cover • Select suitable fabrics • Adapt styles & look at ideas

10	Dining Chair Covers – Day 2		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Measure each section • Calculate fabric quantities • Allow for seams • Make & apply piping • Fit your chair cover • Select suitable fabrics • Calculate for skirts where needed • Longer or short skirts

You do not need to bring anything along – just your favourite sewing machine or use ours - as everything is included for you to complete your ‘samples’ & assessment pieces.

After each day here, you will take home notes, manuals & your relevant sample. You will then have the notes to refer to, along with your sample to recap on, to enable you to make your replica piece at home, at your leisure. You will then bring it along to a later session for assessment when completed at home, which will then go towards your final certificate of your Soft Furnishings achievements at Sewing Tuition.

There will be opportunities to learn other techniques that will assist you with your journey whilst attending. Session times are 10am to 3pm for your small group, ‘one on one’ tuition.

We aim to help you achieve your goals, supporting you in-between your days in our workroom.
